### HER IMPERIAL MAJESTY'S GRACIOUS MESSAGE

"We are pleased to have this opportunity of greeting the delegates to the Fifteenth International Red Cross Conference which convenes to-day at Tokyo. Every year has witnessed, thanks to the co-operation and united effort of the nations, a marked progress in the activities of the Red Cross. Now that its labours are being extended to the broader field of humanitarian work in time of peace, We feel confident that the Red Cross will serve to promote the cause of international friendship and universal brotherhood. It is Our sincere hope that the present conference will make a solid contribution towards the fulfilment of the noble mission of the Red Cross."

### CONFERENCE NOTES

At the opening meeting of the Conference on Saturday, October 20, the proposals of the Board of Delegates regarding the persons to be appointed as officers of the Conference were unanimously adopted.

At 9 A.M. on Saturday morning H.E. Prince Tokugawa, Judge Payne and Mr. de Planta broadcast to listeners in the United States describing

the plans for the Conference and the hopes of success entertained by all participating. The first half hour of the opening session was broadcast throughout the Japanese Empire and at 6 P.M. on Saturday those who had spoken during this period, repeated their speeches over the radio for re-transmission to listeners in Europe from the wireless station in Berlin.
