DRAFT RESOLUTION ON THE SPEEDY
REPATRIATION OF JAPANESE NATIONALS

Submitted by the Japanese
Red Cross Delegation

Whereas after seven years from the end of the Second World War there still exist a considerable number of Japanese nationals who have not been able to return to their country, and

Whereas from the point of view of the humanitarian principles of the Red Cross such a regrettable situation must be redressed, therefore

The XVIII International Red Cross Conference resolves that those Japanese nationals who are still held abroad should be returned home as soon as possible to be reunited with their families.
