Draft Resolution

Considering that as a result of the Second World War, a large number of persons, adults and children, are still prevented from being reunited with their families:

Recommends that the National Societies of the Red Cross act as natural intermediaries between themselves and their respective Governments to facilitate to the greatest possible extent the liberation of these persons, to obtain information concerning their fate and to facilitate the sending of material relief,

Expresses the hope that the current meeting in Toronto of the National Societies and of the Governments will enable the establishment of the necessary contacts for organizing this humanitarian task of mutual aid, which is the very purpose and the "raison d'être" of the International Red Cross.
