Abstract:	<p>Traditionally, the ICRC has concentrated on mine-action initiatives and on assisting survivors of mines, cluster munitions and explosive remnants of war (ERW) because of, among others, its extensive operational presence in conflict/violence-affected areas and its role in developing and implementing IHL and related legal frameworks. Over the years – particularly in light of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD) – the ICRC has begun to work towards addressing the specific needs of persons with disabilities in a more inclusive and comprehensive manner. Beginning with the Appeal for 2015, physical rehabilitation activities for all persons with disabilities began to be included in the Special Appeals. This Special Report covers these, as well as initiatives related to mine action; in addition, it summarizes the ICRC's wider approach to addressing the needs of persons with disabilities, including its other efforts to facilitate the social and economic aspects of inclusion.</p>
